Company Overview Bella Coola Heli Sports operates in the glaciated wilderness of BC's central coast. We provide world-class skiing in the winter and connect our guests with incredible wilderness adventures in the summer. We operate from five remote properties, three of which are in the Tatla Lake region of the Chilcotin's, and two which are in the Bella Coola Valley. We boast the largest heli-skiing tenure of any operator in the world and our Himalayan like mountains draw outdoor enthusiasts from around the world.

Job Description & Responsibilities The Ski Tech / Maintenance position is a dynamic role. Successful candidate must enjoy being on their feet, interacting with guests, and tackling an array of tasks both big and small. This is a fast-paced position that requires a high-degree of initiative and a sound eye for detail.

The Ski Tech plays a key role in our guest's experience, and they must be flexible to the needs of our guests. Essential duties and responsibilities include: maintaining the ski fleet, snowboards, poles, and bindings, adjusting bindings and settings to support the need of each guest, maintain accurate inventory records associated with all hardgoods and tools needed to maintain the fleet, maintain a clean and professional work area, be willing to assist other members of the lodge team as needed.

This position also lends support to maintenance related tasks. Duties and responsibilities here include snow removal, maintaining clean vehicles, luggage handling, fuelling of helicopters and vehicles, garbage and recycling removal, and transporting guests or supplies.

Candidates are expected to demonstrate tidy grooming and a professional appearance, and to follow OH&S, food safe, and WHMIS best-practices.

Working Environment This type of lodge work is challenging and demanding. This job is in a remote area of British Columbia, and employees are required to find their way to and from our transportation staging areas in the Sea-to-Sky corridor. Candidates must contribute positively to the team, both at the work post, and towards the lodge experience in general, and there must be a willingness to assist other members of the lodge team, as needed.
